Next week we will start our spring MAP testing. As a reminder, MAP is the standardized assessment that we give twice a year for students in Kindergarten through Grade 8. It is an adaptive test that provides us a wealth of important information. We use the data for teaching and learning as well as curriculum development. After the MAP is complete, we will celebrate our students who scored in the 99th percentile for achievement or growth in either math, reading, or language usage. As an FYI, we do retest some students if we feel their results are not representative – as we all know, sometimes we have off days. We love the spring MAP assessment as we it shows how much our students have grown over the academic year. You will receive your child(ren)'s results at the end of the school year.

Three quick notes about drop off and pick up, fully realizing the issues that Canton is currently having with traffic and construction on Washington Street. For drop off, please do not park in the middle spots with the no parking sign. You can instead park on the side or in the back of the school, where there is plenty of parking available each day. Parking in these spots is a safety concern for families walking through the parking lot. Also, if you are walking your child to the front door, you must stay with them until they enter the building. Finally, I have also fielded numerous complaints from residents at the Canton Housing Authority facility next door concerning SJS parents taking their parking spots and ensuing difficult conversations. Please be aware that those spots are not St. John School parking spaces.
