Dear St. John School Kindergarten through Grade 7 parents,

Thank you to each of you for the support you give your child every day. Our students come to school prepared and excited to learn. We are so grateful that we are partners in the education of your child.

It is now time to start the reenrollment process for all students for the 2025-2026 school year.

To complete our online reenrollment process, you will access the FACTS Family Portal through your existing login. The online process should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Your information will be saved if you need to quit and come back later.

## To access Family Portal:

- Please go to <u>www.factsmgt.com</u>
- Select **Parent Log In** from the menu bar and **FACTS Family Portal** from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.
- After logging in, click on **Apply/Enroll** in the left menu.
- Click on the **Enrollment/Reenrollment** link

At the end of the process, you will be charged a \$300 non-refundable seat deposit paid online through FACTS. You can use a bank account or a credit card. This seat deposit will go toward your 2025-2026 tuition. There will be an additional \$11 fee you will need to pay to FACTS for processing.

Reenrollment for the 2025-2026 school year is due by Friday, January 17 at noon. If you do not fill out the online paperwork by January 17, your seat cannot be guaranteed for next school year. If your child is not returning to SJS, please let us know or indicate it online. In addition, if you are 2 months behind in tuition and/or incidentals, you will be blocked from reenrolling until payment is made or a plan is put in place.

We have set tuition for the 2025-2026 school year. Please see the attached tuition structure. You will see an increase in tuition for prekindergarten and

above. Besides continuing to provide our teachers with an adequate raise, we, like many other businesses, have seen a dramatic rise in the costs of most everything and everyone we use at St. John School including electric, heat, copying, health insurance, janitorial, and facilities upkeep. This increase in tuition allows us to continue to offer the high-quality education that we pride ourselves on, that you as parents expect, and that our students deserve.

The financial aid application for the 2025-2026 school year is also available through FACTS by visiting https://factsmgt.com/aid. If you already have an account, just sign in. If you are applying for financial aid for the first time, you will need to create an account and select St. John School, Canton. Financial Aid applications are due March 15, and we will make decisions in early April. Approximately 10% of St. John School students receive some type of financial aid which can range from \$500 to \$2,000.
