The SJS Christmas Concert will occur on Friday at 10:00 am in St. Oscar Romero Church. Church doors will open for the concert at 9:30 am (after the 9:00 am Mass). The back parking lot will remain open all day for parking since parking spots will be at a premium. All students will return to school after the concert, quickly grab their belongings and head immediately to their dismissal area (side door for PS and PK and gym for K – Grade 8). No students will be dismissed from Church and there is no aftercare available. Please see below for dress code.

Also, next week, we have three possible out of uniform days. On Wednesday, students can wear pajamas to school – this does include slippers. On Thursday, students may wear a Christmas/Ugly Sweater or Christmas themed/colored shirt to school (they still must be in school uniform pants/skort). On Friday, instructions for the Christmas Concert are below.

Over the past few weeks, I have been keeping track of a few reminders for parents. It has become a small list of things, so please remember the following:

- -St. John School is a peanut free school. No foods with peanut butter are allowed in any form.
- -During morning drop off, please remember that students need to exit the car by themselves. If they need parent support, please park and walk them to the

Main Entrance. Also, you can only park across from the Church/school or in the back parking lot.

- -Please drive carefully in the parking lot as many times there are people walking through. We have had a few instances where drivers have been too aggressive and/or not paying attention. Also, please relay this message to anyone who picks up as these issues have been non-parents at times.
- -Students must have a coat to go outside in the winter. If they do not have one, they will not be allowed outside. A hat and gloves are also greatly appreciated.
- -When a student is sick or becomes sick at school, please remember the 24-hour rule. Students cannot return to school from a fever or vomiting for 24 hours.
- -If a student is absent from school or leaves school early because of sickness, they cannot participate in evening SJS events like basketball and drama.
- -If your child will be absent, please email the teacher and Mrs. Foster. Also, please include Nurse Kiley if it is a medical absence/sickness.

Finally, National Junior Honor Society will take a break from tutoring the next few weeks so there will be no tutoring on December 19 or January 2. NJHS Tutoring will return on Thursday, January 9.
